AGENDA

→ Minutes from 2-9-23:

The Council reviewed and approved the minutes with no corrections or concerns.

→ Discuss Upcoming 2022-2023 Plan including Goals, Expenditures, and Other Related Matters:

The current School Land Trust school goal which stated students would increase proficiency in reading to 65% and in math to 62% by Middle-of-Year benchmark assessments. Based on data retrieved from MOY assessments, Ferron Elementary demonstrated growth of 11% in reading from 55% to 65% and showed 18% growth in math going from 50% to 68% proficiency. Both subject areas met and exceeded the SLT goal so conversation progressed in moving forward with setting a new goal for the upcoming SLT plan for 2023-24 school year. After thorough discussion, it was agreed upon that the Council felt comfortable in continuing to keep the same goal and changing the proficiency goal to be 70% in both reading and math. Expenditures designated in the SLT will remain similar as in previous years' plans to continue ongoing support to help achieve this student growth goal.

→ End of Year and Upcoming School Year Planning

The SCC discussed their upcoming Student Etiquette dinner to be held on Fri., April 14th during normal lunch time. The dinner will conclude FE's week long Kindness theme. Assignments include:

- Heather- arrange the dinner being served with the food service program. Make invitations and ask teachers and students to make decorations.
- JennieLin- short videos on manners/table manners, proper etiquette, etc. to be shared w/ teachers to review w/ students.
- Kenzie- paper plates, napkins, utensils, etc.
- Christella- Kindness lessons presented in the classroom during the week. Letters w/ kind messages will be made for table center pieces.
- Erin, Hollie, Megan, Jessica & other Council members- set up tables in gym, play dinner music, serve students and clean up/prep for the next group.
- Student Council will also be invited to help implement the dinner.

Art Show- The Council set the dates for this year's Art Show to be held May 15th-19th. Entries will be judged by the Council on May 15th & 16th and then it will be opened up to the public and parents for viewing May 17th-19th. Each entry needs to be numbered on the front w/ no names. Winners will be given a ribbon with an artist winner and Excellence Award for each grade. Bronco Coal Mine is sponsoring the cost of the full Art Show including prizes. Each student will receive a participation award. Heather will discuss w/ Angela Huntington, art teacher, a theme idea and implementation of creating art projects during her class times. Full award winners will be announced during FE's end of year Awards Assembly on May 25th. Preschool and kindergarten will be out of session so winners from those classes will be invited back to the assembly.
