Ferron Elementary Attendance Incentive Program

Ferron Elementary is excited to begin an Attendance Incentive Program! Now that our second term is off to a great start, we are going to track student attendance and provide positive rewards throughout the term for those meeting the criteria. Students that commit to meeting the attendance goal will earn an end-of-term party with Principal Behling.

Now we obviously understand that perfect attendance isn't always realistic, we don't want kids to come to school sick or miss out on family functions that may occur. However, attendance is a critical component to student success- both academically and socially. We hope parents will support us in our drive to achieve high attendance school-wide.

Students must be in full attendance 90% of the term in order to be included in the end-of-term party. There will also be periodical attendance checks with positive rewards given to those students on-track to meet our attendance goal.

Our attendance goal is also in alignment with the State and District guidelines.

Policy: JE-Student Attendance and Truancy Intervention- Excessive Absence

Absence from school for six (6) or more days, or portions of a school day during one (1) term, not including school-excused absences, shall be considered as "excessive absence" under this policy.

Students can have approximately four (4) excused absences per term to stay in compliance with District policy and to meet the attendance goal.
