

School Land Trust (SLT) Expenditure Summary 2019-20

2019-20 SLT allocation was \$38,842. The SLT money distributed to Ferron Elementary School for the 2019-20 school was spent according to the plan as submitted in the spring of 2019. Funds were used to facilitate the continues use of academic computer software programs and literacy periodicals including: Accelerated Reader, Write Bright, Scholastic and Explorer Magazines. Money was also portioned to keep our technology equipment computer lab and supplies current with renewed licenses and necessary supplies. Funding also supported the original purchase of 15 Chromebooks and one SmartTV. Due to the soft closure caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in the Spring of 2020, unused monies purchased an additional 10 Chromebooks and Chromebook cart to provide a full classroom cart. Investment in personnel was also allocated to support professional development for staff. This included the attendance to the Solution Tree PLC conference to enhance the District's professional development goal of increasing and utilizing Professional Learning Communities (PLCs). Personnel investment also covered the wages and benefits of a 29.5 hr/wk paraprofessional for additional classroom support. Based on the Plan's identified five goals, student performance and achievement in language arts, mathematics, science and technology made adequate to significant progress up to the soft closure beginning March 13, 2020.
